

# Rome: A kitten was raped in Tor Tre Teste. The Metropolitan City's Environment Commissioner files a complaint.

A kitten, known as Reisi, belonging to a feline colony in Tor Tre Teste, was found dying in a condominium garden. According to the animal rights groups that reported the incident, the kitten was apparently raped. The Metropolitan City of Rome's Delegate for the Environment and Animal Welfare was involved in the case. **Rocco Ferraro**, who will file a complaint with the prosecutor's office. Meanwhile, the kitten is being cared for by veterinarians and local associations.

"This incident is of unprecedented gravity and cannot be considered an isolated incident. We are faced with a fact that directly questions the issue of security and territorial control. As local institutions, we are doing everything possible, following the case step by step and preparing a complaint with the prosecutor's office, in coordination with the relevant authorities," Ferraro said in a statement. **"Nova Agency"**, "But it's clear that incidents of this nature require a broader reflection on local governance and the tools available to prevent and combat similar acts," Ferraro added. "I want to thank the residents who rescued Reisi and the veterinarians who are caring for her tirelessly; the community's response was immediate and demonstrates great sensitivity. Now, however, a further effort is needed in terms of security, because those who commit acts of violence of this nature represent a danger that cannot be underestimated. I appeal to anyone who can provide useful information: identifying the perpetrator is an absolute priority and a necessary signal for the entire area."

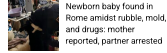

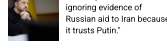

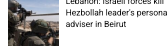
