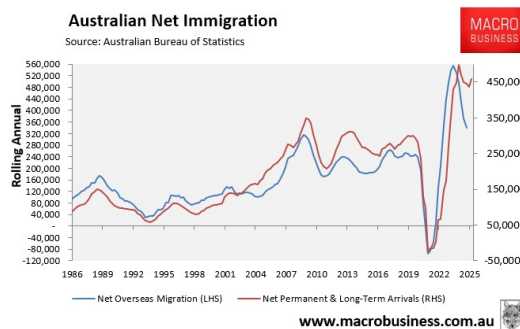

In the first half of 2025, a record 279,460 net permanent and long-term arrivals landed in Australia, up 13,080 (5%) from the 266,380 net arrivals that landed last year and 108,890 (64%) higher than the same period in 2019, before the pandemic.”

As to your question ... more people = more economic activity, giving the appearance of economic growth.

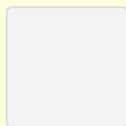

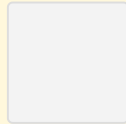
Marches are good advertisements. But, short lived influence.

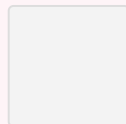

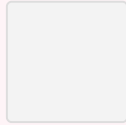

The answer to that is; "Where? No, not a news site, I get my facts by accessing the actual published data. I have the link, would you like me to text it to you?"

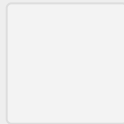
It shuts down derision, because now they have to act, it shows if they are useful idiots, or prepared to educate themselves.

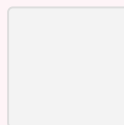
who held much the same values except she was even more woke.

But why the surge?

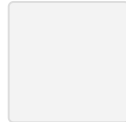

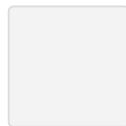
Thankfully you don't represent the majority of Australia, who support immigration, but understand the control needed to integrate

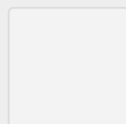
